**Items NOT accepted:** explosives, radioactive wastes, biological/infectious wastes, medical wastes, paint, tires, batteries, electronics, appliances, smoke detectors.

Improper disposal of these items can contaminate nearby water bodies and wetlands. In addition long term storage of these chemicals can be a public safety hazard. The City of Savannah Water Resource Bureau is committed to working with residents to protect our water resources.

The collection will be from 9:00 a.m. until noon, Saturday, September 17. This is a drive thru collection event. All chemicals must be in legibly marked containers. Traffic will be routed into West Mac Arthur Drive and existing down Seawright Drive. The event is sponsored by the City of Savannah Water Resources Bureau, Nexeo Solutions, and JCB.
